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Housing

Supportive Housing services feature intensive case management by professional staff. They assist the homeless individuals and families with rental assistance; deposits for security and utilities; emergency supplies of food, clothing, furniture, appliances, and other housing start-up items. Other benefits include outpatient health services, limited transportation, and child care. The case managers make up the SSAT (Self-Sufficiency Assurance Team.) The team receives referrals from many sources, most of whom have long been partners in the local Coalition for the Homeless.

Participants in the program are expected to maintain enrollment in all recommended supportive services and vocational/educational programs. Close monitoring by the case managers will assure compliance.

Appropriate Referrals to Supportive Housing:

Low income, homeless individuals or families, including those with disabilities

Eligibility Requirements:

Proof of income and homelessness; ability to live alone with supportive services.
