Our Home Weatherization Assistance Program (HWAP) is on a roll. The agency recently purchased two new vehicles for our crews to use on the job. (HWAP) provides eligible Ohioans with assistance to improve the energy efficiency of their homes and reduce their energy costs. Ohioans participating in the HWAP will receive a home inspection to identify the services necessary to improve their homes energy efficiency. The HWAP Crew works year-round. They insulated attics, blow cellulose into sidewalls, and caulk windows and doors.


