Monthly Program Highlight

Home Energy Assistance Program

Eligible low-income Ohioans meet the high cost of home heating. HEAP pays a one-time payment for most PUCO regulated utility customers reflecting their usage for the current winter heating season. A special component of HEAP, the Winter Crisis Program (WCP) (November 1 – March 31) is administered by Community Action Agencies (CAA's) throughout Ohio. The WCP provides assistance once per heating season to eligible households that are disconnected, threatened with disconnection, or have less than a ten-day supply of bulk fuel.

Eligibility Requirements: proof of income (175% of poverty guidelines); Social Security Cards, Proof of Citizenship, most recent gas and electric bill and/or bulk fuel slip.
