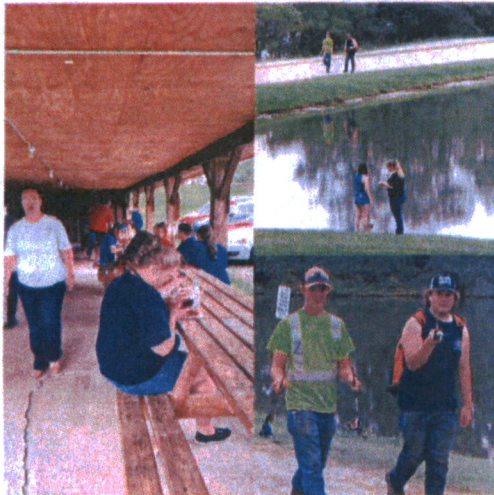
CCMEP SUMMER PICNIC!

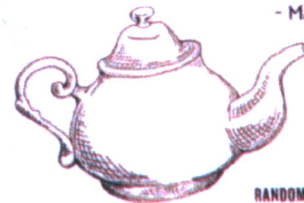
