United Way- Families at Risk of Homelessness

United Way funding is used to provide rental assistance for families at risk of homelessness. Payment from the program guarantees an additional 30 days at the residence. The Families at Risk of Homelessness has been in existence for several years and is very successful. The program occurs January-December. Rental Assistance benefits low-income members of the community by reducing the number of individuals and families who would otherwise resort to living in shelters, on the street, or doubled up in unstable living arrangements. This program reduces the family's exposure to hardship and improves the household's chance at achieving long-term self-sufficiency.
