HEAP Summer Crisis

The Summer Crisis Program falls under our Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP). In our HEAP Summer Crisis Program, the agency helps with utilities (electric only), by providing air conditioners and fans once every three years, and assisting with deposits on new services or transfers of old bills.

This program runs July 1st – September 30th. To be eligible, the total household income must be at or below 175% of federal poverty guidelines, with a household member age 60 or older and/or a household member with a documented medical condition, a disconnect notice, have been shut off, transfer service or are trying to establish new service on their electric bill.
